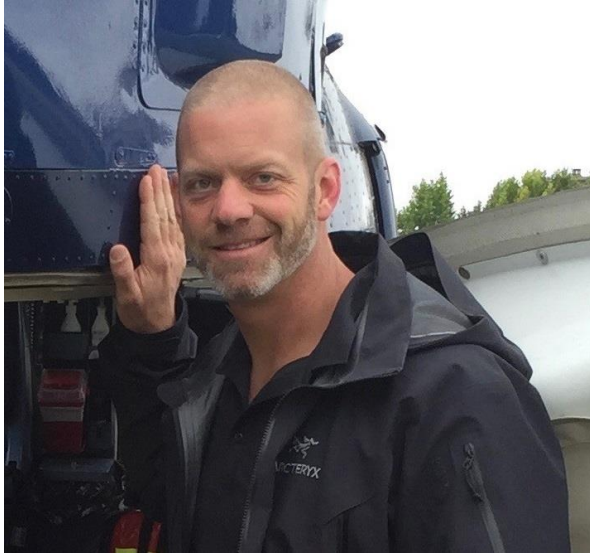


Welcome Dr. Matt Evenhouse – NAAMTA Medical Director
